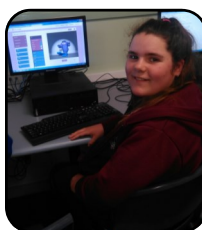

- Student's name. If pay for more than one student please use eldest child's name.
- Class name. (Kinder, 1/2, 3/4/5 or 5/6)
- Reference. What's the payment for (ie; Just Singing, Tennis, Soccer, etc.).
- Your full name, contact number and email address.

What else must I do?

- Print receipt issued from Westpac at time of payment. (The school will not be issuing one)
- Return signed permission notes/envelopes with notation that you have paid via POP.

Please remember: Payment online does not replace a signed permission note for excursions. These must still be received by the school.
