Footsteps Monday 10 October 2016

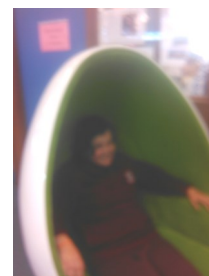
First day of Term
