Multicultural Day

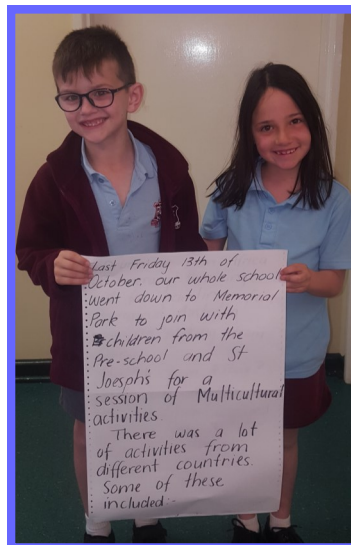
Last Friday 13 October, our whole school went down to Memorial Park to join with children from Pre-School and St Joseph's for a session of multicultural activities.

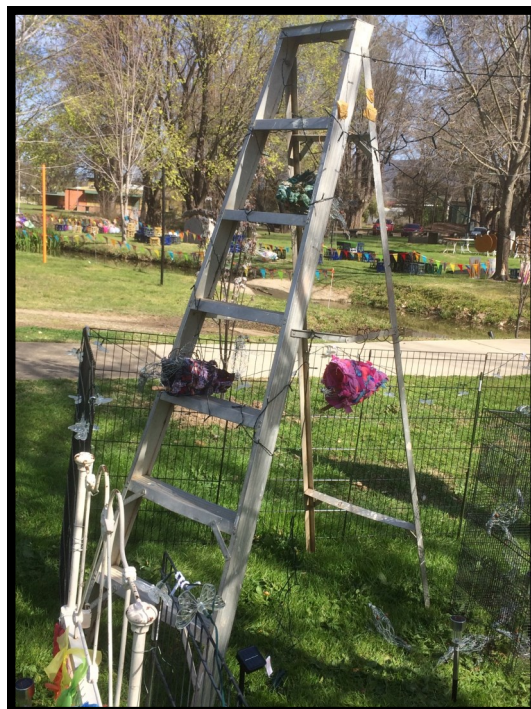
Congratulations to all the students pictured below. These students participated in the University of NSW Testing Program for students Australia wide. There were some pleasing results and well done to all participants.
