“WELCOME TO OUR SOUTH KOREAN FRIENDS TO SUSHI MAKING AUSTRALIAN STYLE”



In order to enhance their cultural awareness and as an added link to their “sister” school in South Korea, Class 5/6 has the opportunity to participate in a cooking lesson last Friday.

We made sushi rolls, following the recipe that was demonstrated to us from a previous video link with the South Korean students.

We also incorporated some International Studies, learning about the origins of sushi.

Below is what some of the students had to say about the lesson:

Sped Pearce: “On the November 3rd, Class 5/6 made sushi rolls. Our friends from South Korea sent us their recipe for making sushi. First we put a Nori sheet (which is seaweed) on our bamboo mats then filled it with rice then left an inch. Then we put our fillings in which was carrot, ham and cucumber. We rolled it tight using the inch that was left to make it stick. We got to eat our sushi. We made some for the teachers and took leftovers home. It was a lot of fun and they tasted delicious.”

Julie Bambling: “Last Friday 5/6 made some sushi! We partnered up and watched a video showing us what to do. Then Mrs Thake handed out some sushi mats, while Mrs Mac handed out gloves for us to wear. We were given some nori, which is the seaweed part, then we put some rice on the nori and smoothed it out evenly. We put the filling in and rolled it up, the rolling was probably the hardest part. Then Mrs Thake cut them into 4 so each person had 2 pieces. We all made some for the teaching staff. We all thought it was delicious!!”

Cody Grady: “We had a variety of ingredients to put in our sushi. There was lemon and pepper tuna, long slices of ham, carrot, cucumber and spinach. When we laid our nori out we then put ice on it. Then after that it’s ready to put your ingredients on. We then rolled it and sliced it up. It’s now ready to eat. Mine was alright.”
