School Swimming Carnival Tomorrow Friday 3 February

This Friday, students in Classes 1/2, 3/4 and 5/6 will attend the swimming carnival at the Adelong Swimming Pool.

Any students who are 8 years old in 2017 and are able to swim 25 metres or more non-stop and unaided are also invited to participate, however only students who can swim 50 metres non-stop/unaided are eligible to compete at the PSSA district carnival in Tumut. All non-swimmers will be cheering for their houses. Students in Year 1/2 will also have some organised activities in the small pool and the splash park.

Pool entry for the 2017 Swimming Carnival is \$3.00 payable at the pool. All parents are to pay their entry at the pool. Season tickets may be used.

Students will walk to the pool for the carnival to commence at 9.30 am. Students will have ages and house teams written on hands at school before departing. Students will return to school in time to catch buses. Parents may, of course, collect their children from the pool, but must inform their teacher before doing so and sign them out.

All students are to bring hat, sunscreen, morning tea and lunch, adequate water and drink for the day. Some confectionary will be for sale from the kiosk as well as drinks.

No fizzy drinks are allowed to be purchased by students or for students to drink.

The Canteen will be running a sausage sizzle for lunch. These will be \$2.00 each. No ordering is required.

Parental help would be appreciated to assist with the running of the carnival. Parent help is needed for a variety of jobs (ie: starter, rescuer, judges/timekeepers). If you are able to assist Please see Mrs Hall.
