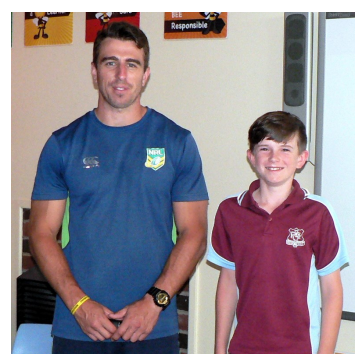
## NRL Visit
