If you child/children would like to order lunch, please return the attached envelope by Wednesday 14 March. There is one envelope per family. It should be a great day.

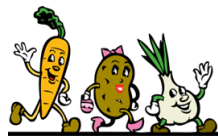
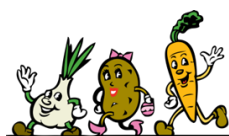


102nd Adelong Show
