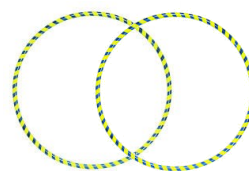

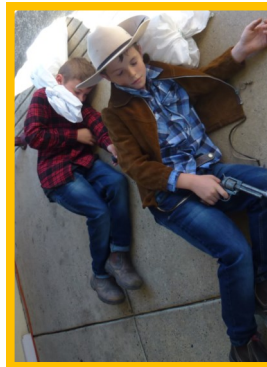

The stall will be open in Week 3 of Term 2.

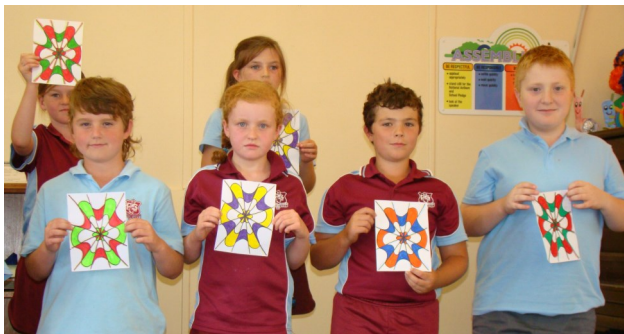
If your child would like to purchase a gift, could you please send their money to the office in an envelope with their name on it.
