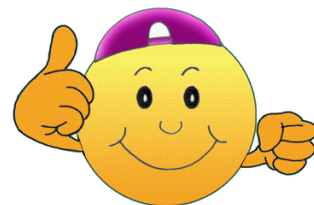

- Buy fresh foods that are not packaged i.e. fruit and veg



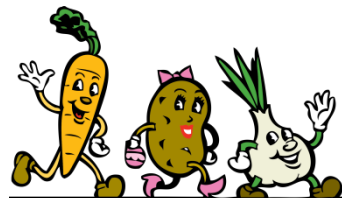
