Exciting Ella eats enormous eggs extremely energetically very early everyday.

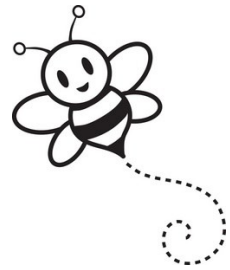
Cheeky colourful Charlotte likes creating carrot cupcakes.
