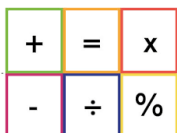
Congratulations to all our competitors, especially Hunter who was so close to making the State Carnival in the 100 Metre Dash.

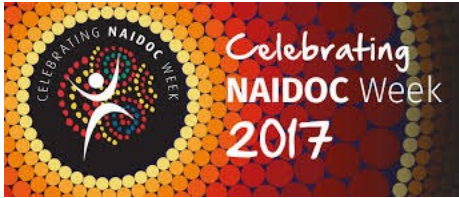

Last Friday, 8th September, staff and students celebrated NAIDOC Day at our school. We invited "Aunty Sue" Bulger to help organise some cultural activities that we could enjoy on the day.

"Uncle Pat" Connolly taught the children some songs that used Wiradjuri words and the boys attempted to play the didgeridoo, while the girls tapped along with the clap sticks.

Jess Bulger and her husband Andrew bought along some hats and the children did some screen printing on their hats with their own animal designs.

"Aunty Winnie" Bulger taught the children the Wiradjuri words for many of our body parts. They enjoyed playing Bingo and singing a song using these words.

Finally, "Aunty Sue" Bulger, played an Aboriginal Dreaming story called 'Tiddalick the Frog'. Children discussed the morals of the story and coloured in a picture.

Staff and students thoroughly enjoyed the day and would like to thank our visitors for their time and efforts conducting the day for us.

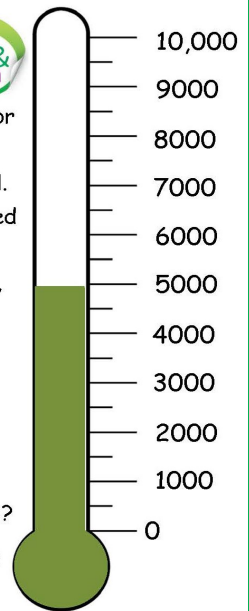


Thank you so much for your continued support of our school. We have now collected 4980 stickers. We only have, just under, one more week to collect as many stickers as we can.
