Don't forget to support the P&C's BBQ at the show again this year. A little reminder that if anyone is able to assist please contact Angela Ward. A BBQ roster is

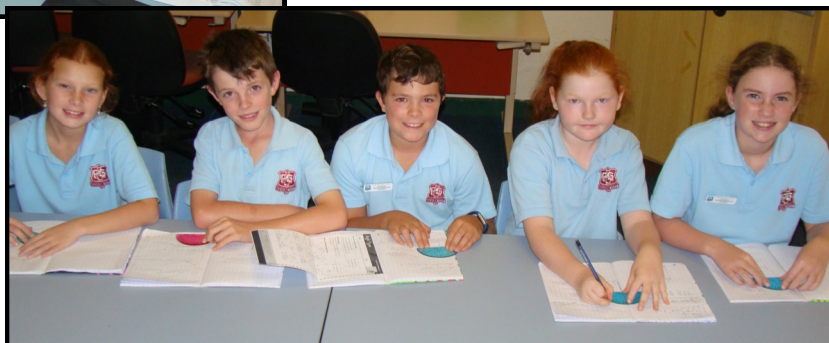
The Diary of a Wimpy Kid
