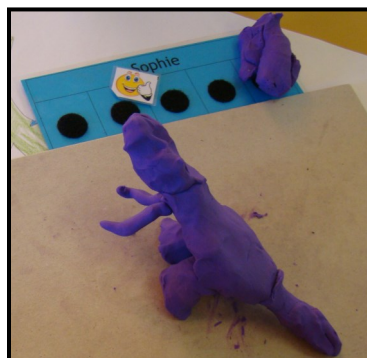
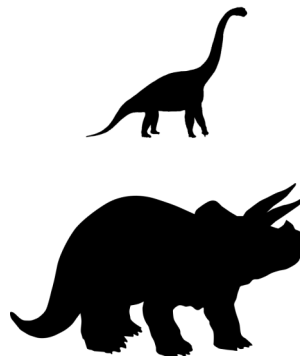
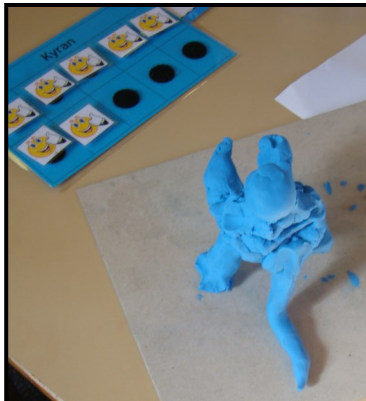
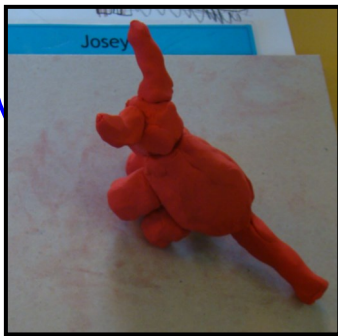


K/1 DINOSAUR MADNESS
