Tuesday 20 August 2019 – Interactive Reading and Viewing. Creative Arts


Tuesday 10 September 2019 - Early Numeracy Games and Science






Gymnastics

2/3/4 History

5/6 Virtual Classroom—Korea

This year the 5/6 class are participating in a project with The University of New England Asia ConneXions Departments and the Busan Daechung Elementary School, Busan City, South Korea. The project runs over the year and 8 Virtual Classroom (VC) sessions. In these sessions the children are going to teach the South Korean students about their life and schooling in Australia and the South Korean students will do the same. On the 5th of June we had our first VC session and introduced our school and our students to Busan. It was a lot of fun! Our last VC was on the 19th of June and focused on music.


