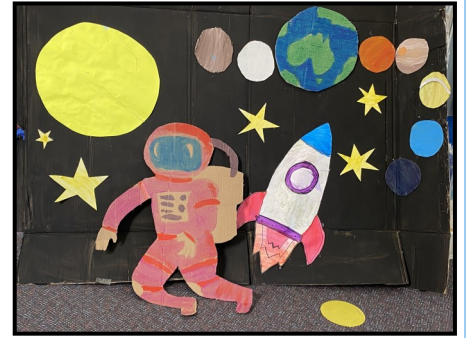
## National Simultaneous Storytime
