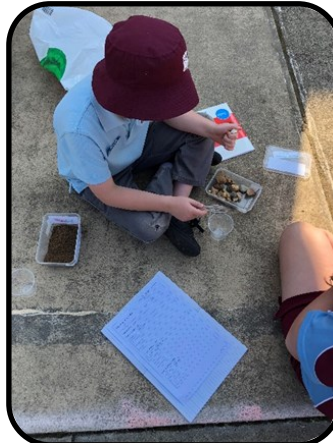

SCHOOL RADIO NEWS

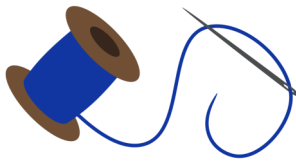
